

Commissioners Patrick Clawson, John Brown and William Brown met in a Public Hearing on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 2013 at 1:00 p.m. to address the vacation of 5 public roads. The vacations were published in the Carroll County Comet and all parties were notified by certified mail.

**1050 W between 200 N and Bicycle Bridge Road (Lovers Lane)**

One property owner in attendance asked if they would still have access to their field. They were informed they would so they had no objection. William Brown moved to accept Ordinance 2012-05 in its entirety; John Brown seconded; passed unanimously.

**900 N Between State Road 25 and 100 E (in Town of Burrows):**

As a result of this vacation, the right-of-way will be given back to the property owners. The Highway Department will install a guard rail with a road closed sign. William Brown made a motion to accept Ordinance 2012-06, John Brown seconded; passed unanimously.

**100 N from 800 W to new State Road 25 (Hoosier Heartland Highway):**

There will need to be a utility easement for this portion. William Brown made a motion to enact Ordinance 2013-07 in its entirety. John Brown seconded; passed unanimously.

**500 S from 75 W to the Wildcat Creek (aka "No Bridge Rd"):**

William Brown made a motion to accept Ordinance 2013-08 in its entirety; John Brown seconded; passed unanimously.

**265 W from 600 N to Rockfield:**

William Brown made a motion to accept Ordinance 2013-09; John Brown seconded; passed unanimously.

Being no objections; all Ordinances will be in full force and effect and approved on first reading this 17<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2013.

No other business was discussed and the meeting was adjourned by motion made by William Brown and seconded by John Brown, passed unanimously.
