Baseball & Softball

Town & County Baseball & Softball League covers several counties including Carroll. It sponsors co-ed sports for children from ages eight to 14.

The **Burlington Jr. League** sponsors Little League and Girls Softball as well as T-ball for boys and girls ages 4-6. Little League has teams for ages 6-8, 9-10, and 11-12. Girls softball has teams for 8, 10, 12, and 14 and under.
