The Flora Community Park is home to shelter houses for small family groups and playgrounds for children.

Organized youth summer sports activities are hosted here. Pony League, Little League, Girls Softball, and more.

The park also includes a horse show arena, picnic grounds, and a playground. The Carolina Community Center is also located here.

The Merchants' Building is used for the annual [Carol County Flower and Garden Fair](#) in April. A Scout camp is also held here.

A fenced-in "tot" playground gives a special opportunity for smaller children to enjoy the surroundings.
