

The seven-acre community park is at the north edge of Camden in Jackson Township.

The park includes modern restrooms, three ball fields with bleachers (two with lights, above-ground).

Parking is available at each diamond and at the entrance to the park. Two horseshoe pits are available.

In 2008 a new 26-activity playground structure was built by volunteers for children ages two to twelve.
